KEY LEARNING: My Communication SOW

At Heron personalised communication opportunities are embedded throughout the school day during lesson and leisure times, in line with pupils' PLIMS and SaLT personalised programmes. Total Communication Approaches are carefully adapted to meet pupils' individual needs.

The ten areas of communicative learning are individually assessed and mapped. SOW: Literacy for Life, My Drama, Thinking and Problem Solving, Numeracy for Life, The World About Me

Book Choice: These sessions focus on exploring a text, learning key vocabulary and its meaning, learning about the characters, making predictions, relating experiences to real life, and developing communication skills. This is achieved through selected book exploration.
